There is a Waiting list for the PAC Waiver. If you do not turn in any paperwork that DCF sends you they will close your case and you will then go onto the PAC Waiver waiting list. So please do not ignore any letters from DCF.

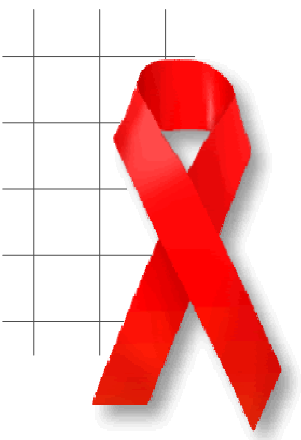
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Why all the authorizations for PAC services expire in April!

If you are a client in PAC waiver and are receiving services other than Case Management your Authorization expires on April 30th 2014. We are not sure at this time what the process is going to be to get those services approved in the future. So please bear with us as we attempt to get your services continued past April 30th. This does not mean that you are losing case management after April 30th. All PAC Waiver recipients automatically receive case management. These are the services that people receive extra such as; massage therapy, durable medical equipment, homemaker, etc. Also remember that just because a service is offered in PAC Waiver it does not mean that you automatically qualify just because you are in PAC Waiver. There are certain criteria that must be met in order to qualify for these services.

The waiting list is still in effect for any new PAC Waiver enrollees. So remember to keep in contact with your case manager. If you lose contact then you will go onto the statewide waiting list and it could be another year before you can get back onto PAC Waiver. 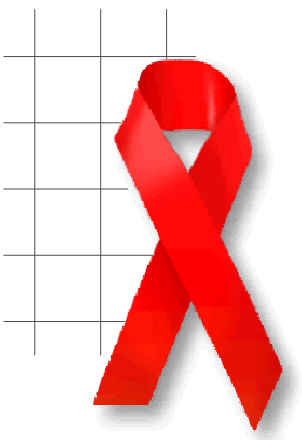

AHCA is sending out letters that talk about needing to choose your Medicaid plan by June 1st. Just remember that when choosing your Medicaid plan you need to make sure that your doctors take that plan or you will need to change doctors.
