What it does apply to:

- 1 Clothing, footwear and certain accessories 100 dollars or less
- 2 Certain school supplies 15 dollars or less per item
- 3 Personal computers and computer accessories up to 750 dollars for noncommercial use.

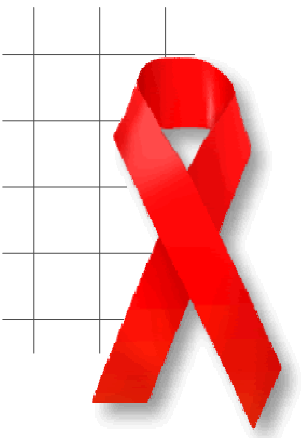
