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Dental and your HMO!

All of the plans cover some dental. Extractions and dentures are covered by your HMO. They also cover a cleaning and X-rays. You should be accessing these services through your HMO. If you need fillings or other services. These are covered by Ryan White. You would then use the Ryan White services that you used before you had this HMO. If the dentist tells you that you need to sign up for Care Credit, be aware that is a credit card. They will then be using this credit card to bill you for services not covered by Medicaid. You do not have to sign up for these extra services. If you have any questions please let your case manager know. We understand how important that dental health is and we encourage everyone to get their teeth cleaned regularly.

Eye Exams and Glasses!

Your Medicaid HMO does cover an eye exam once a year and new lenses every year and new frames every two years. If you need them sooner you can contact AHCA and get an exception, such as if something happens and you can no longer see using the glasses that you have received.
