If you or someone you know is in need of case management, we are always taking new clients. So please feel free to call us.

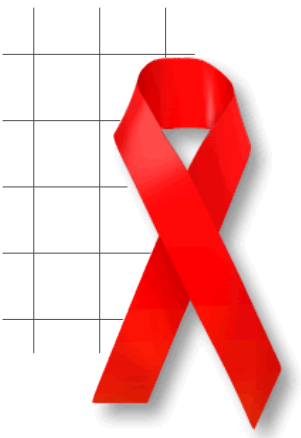
